1. 本系碩士在職專班必須修滿及格必修暨選修課程達 32 學分以上(不含碩士論文 4 學分)，通過本校研究生學位考試規則規定之各項考試及各系所規定專業基本能力檢定,始可畢業。

Students enrolled in the Executive Master's Program of CIOP Department are required to pass a total of 32 credits from required and elective courses (not including 4 credits for master's thesis) and pass the tests listed under the Doctoral and Master's Degree Conferral Regulations of Ming Chuan University and the required professional basic competence tests regulated by their department before graduation.

2. 表列選修科目為預定科目，將依各學期需要開課。

Elective courses listed in this table are the likely courses to be provided, the actual course offerings will be determined based on the actual needs each semester.

3. 選修外所課程以 6 學分為限。未經系主任及指導教授於選課單上認簽之外所選修課程，一律不列計畢業學分數。

Students may take up to 6 credits from other master's programs. Courses that have not been approved and signed off on by the department chair and the master's thesis advisor on the course add and drop form will not be counted toward graduation credits.
